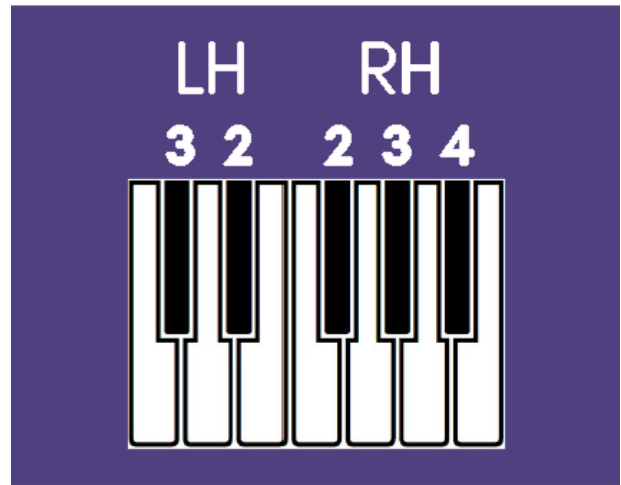


# Jolly Old St. Nicholas
